


WHAT IS APA STYLE?

- APA Style refers to a system of documentation used by the American Psychological Association.
- APA Style is often a requirement of research essays and course papers written in the sciences, medical fields, and business.
- APA Style emphasizes the names of researchers and how current the research is by including authors and years in parenthetical citations: (Hart, 2016).



KEY CHARACTERISTICS

- A separate title page
- A 12-point, serif font such as Times New Roman or sans serif such as Arial
- Parenthetical citations that emphasize author and timeliness: (Smith, 2020)
- Page numbers cited only with direct quotations
- Block quotes of 40+ words
- "Sentence case rules" for capitalization of article and book titles



APA TITLE PAGE

• APA distinguishes between professional papers and student papers. The title page shown here is an example for a student course paper.

IN-TEXT (PARENTHETICAL) CITATIONS

- APA parenthetical citations pair author last names with years of publication to enable readers to match that content to the source in the alphabetized reference list.
- Cite in-text all material that you quote, paraphrase, or summarize.
- Each source cited in-text must also appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.
- Include page numbers only when quoting directly.

NARRATIVE CITATIONS

Narrative citations incorporate author names and publication years into the fabric of sentences.

EXCEPTIONS

- If an online source is not paginated, use paragraph numbers, or direct readers to the source by its title.
- If a source does not have a date, consider the "no date" option.

FORMATTING DIRECT QUOTATIONS

- Use a signal phrase to set up your quote and provide context or attribution.
- Quotations may be broken in two.
- All in-text citations for direct quotations from paginated sources must include page numbers.

BLOCK QUOTATIONS

- If a direct quotation exceeds 40 words in length, format it as a block quote by indenting the entire passage 5 spaces.
- Omit quotation marks in block quotations.
- As with paraphrase or summary, all block quotes require signal phrases and proper citation at the close of the quotation.
- Place the end punctuation at the end of the sentence but before the citation.

As one analyst of open-source, collaborative web projects has written,

Perhaps one of the greatest indications of the collective at work is the recent surge of open-source projects. None of the projects have garnered more attention and widespread appeal than that of Wikipedia. . . This is the premise behind the open-source movement, where the cognitive processes underlying the creation of such resources have been distributed among many. (Hossain, 2012, p. 107)

5 LEVELS OF HEADINGS

APA allows 5 levels of headings that act as transitions between sections of a document to convey the overall organization and structure of an argument.

Level 1: Centered, Boldface, Uppercase and Lowercase

Level 2: Flush Left, Bold Face, Title Case

Level 3: Flush Left, Italics, Title Case

Level 4: Indented 5 spaces, Bold, Title Case, Period.

Level 5: *Indented 5 Spaces, Bold, Italics, Period.*

THE REFERENCE LIST

- Begin the reference list on a new page.
 Alphabetize each entry by author surnames.
- Begin an entry flush left, but indent subsequent lines by 5 spaces, for a "hanging indent."
- Each entry should correspond to a citation in the text of the paper.

ANNOTATIONS

- If the assignment requires an annotation, avoid repeating the publication information already included in the entry.
- Briefly summarize the source's main ideas and relevance to your research topic.
- Maintain the "hanging indent" of 5 spaces for the entire annotation.



FORMATTING FIGURES

- You may place figures (images) at the end of your paper or incorporate them into the text of your paper.
- Number all figures sequentially in boldface
 Arabic numerals, accompanied by a brief,
 clear title in italics.
- If you quote or adapt a figure, acknowledge the source and copyright in a note below.

FORMATTING TABLES

- Tables may be placed at the end of your paper or incorporated into your paper.
- All tables must be numbered sequentially in boldface Arabic numerals, accompanied by a brief, clear title in italics: Table 3: Cost Analysis.
- If you are reproducing or adapting figures or tables using another source, you must acknowledge the copyright of the source in a note below the figure.

USING "CALLOUTS"

- Do not use directional words such as "above" or "below" to refer to figures or tables in your paper.
- Refer to figures and tables only by their numbers and titles. This is known as a "callout."
- Every figure or table included must have a callout in the paper; every callout must correspond to a figure.

Figure 3 depicts the effects of three random variables on the efficacy of sevoflurane in pediatric use.
