# COMMON REFERENCES IN CHICAGO STYLE

## (Notes and Bibliography Form)

Cite sources by including a superscript after a summary, a paraphrase of your own words, or a direct quote. In Microsoft Word, select the "References" tab on PCs or the "Insert" tab on Macs, then choose between footnotes or endnotes. The software will auto-install superscripts in a slightly smaller font, so you can then type the citation in the designated space. The software automatically numbers the sources and adjusts the font size. If you cut or paste text containing superscripts, the software will re-number the sequence automatically. (Note: auto-formatted endnotes will contain superscripts rather than the numerals with periods, both acceptable in Chicago style. Bibliographic form inverts authors' names to determine the alphabetical order of source lists.
