GENERATIVE AI DOCUMENTATION IN MLA STYLE

Documenting Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) safeguards academic integrity, preventing the occurrence of plagiarism or misattribution. Documentation discloses AI usage and how a writer utilized AI for an assignment, paper, or project. This transparency strengthens an author's credibility and trustworthiness since it discloses to the reader how AI helped shape their work. Below is a brief explanation of how GenAI disclosure should appear in two different kinds of in-text citations along with examples of how it should appear on a Works Cited page.

Citations In-Text and Works Cited

“Describe the symbolism of the ruined statue in *Ozymandias*” prompt. *ChatGPT*, model GPT-4o, OpenAI, 8 Jan. 2026, chat.openai.com/chat.

- Citation in prose: According to OpenAI's ChatGPT, the ruined statue in *Ozymandias* symbolizes the passage of time and the inevitable loss of power associated with it.
- Parenthetical citation: Essentially, the ruined statue in *Ozymandias* symbolizes the passage of time and the inevitable loss of power associated with it (“Describe the symbolism”).
